

Operating Military Camp.

January 27th. 1932.

To Mr. Carmen Noguera

Jinotega.

You are hereby notified to deliver the sum of 100 dollars, one part of it in merchandises and the other part in cash. If you pay this contribution of which you have been notified, for the service of the army that defends the sovereignty of Nicaragua, considerations will be granted to you and your properties and if you do not pay, then I come and dispose of you. Do not think that because you are among one thousand or more machos, I can not go in and take you out by your hair. I do not care if you show this paper to the machos. If you want to send the whole Guardia of Jinotega to the battle field and fight, it is all right with me, you can send them against me and I wait for them at any place.

If you look for my protection, it is a thing that can be arranged and you can enjoy the guaranties and your interests will be given complete liberty. You can deliver the whole money in cash or deliver the half of it in clothing, good khaki breeches, undershirts, drawers and hats.
