

presidential's, for it is urgent to end with this indignity which is drowning and making us worthy of hard and just criticism.

And for that, these presents, backed by all and everyone of our common people, has as a notion to exact categorically Adolfo Diaz, Jose Maria Moncada, Emiliano Chamorro, Julian Irias, Carlos Cuadra Pasos, Enoc Aguado, Carlos A. Morales and other political leaders of other localities -who have been preaching the watch word of the "Convenience" of "Not to be in bad relations with the yankee"- to pronounce in public writing if they have decided to let the north american intervention continue in the country, or if at last have forsworned to be "yankeests", that with plain indignation of people have been.

This statement ought to be explicit and contiguous, because if these persons answer with their assent silence, the Nicaraguan popular people would interpret this new demonstration of coward "prudence" as a tacit renovation of "yankee faith" and in such case WE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SECURITY OF THOSE MISERABLE BAD SONS OF NICARAGUA, OF THOSE WHO RESPECT THEM AND OF THE PLUMISTS who do not pronounce about the horrors of the intervention and of the necessity of the instantly leave of marines who are in Nicaragua -as it is requested even in United States- and to never return.

The anti-patriotic infamy must be paid with violence, and people of Nicaragua must apply even the greatest reaction to those who appear adherent to continue the shameful actual conditions, without omitting the adequate punishment in their properties -obtained under the shade of impudicity- so they may regenerate themselves with poverty and make them helpless to do new and greater damages to the country.

This decision that we now take, will be the only way to make ourselves worthy of the fraternal help that with so great opportunity and defeating their own serious economical difficulties have been sent to us by those countries that have demonstrated that they do not forget their brothers who are in adversity.

Countrymen: We have to demonstrate that dignity is not dead in Nicaragua; not only by facing with purpose and resolution before the yankee authority, until we obtain to get them out forever, but to punish without any mercy the political leaders of both parties, who brought the intervention and who maintain it with their silence and inactiveness, and to the Deputies and Senators who have not proceeded to declare void such vile and shameful Guardia treaty that "Legalizes" the iniquity of pretorians. Only on that day, when we inflict definite punishment (and the gallows is the most adequate), we could say that liberty starts for the Nicaraguan people and our regeneration.
